From the Principal's Desk...



Dear Parents,

Last week we were excited to finally welcome our year 3 to 6 students back to face to face learning and it was great to see them engaging positively in their classroom learning. Students settled into class routines and expectations while teachers utilized this time to learn more about them and their interests.

Last Friday, students at school were spoilt with special treats.

Class newsletters were sent out to all families last week and if you are yet to receive your child's please contact their classroom teacher.

Whilst we have taken necessary precautions to keep students and staff safe, unfortunately, we have had a few cases of COVID within the school. We have acted quickly and passed on information as soon as we have been notified. We continue to ask families to contact the school **immediately** if their child, or a household member, is COVID positive or a close contact and needs to be in quarantine. If we receive this information quickly we are able to start the contact tracing process to limit the number of additional positive COVID cases on site.

Again, I reiterate, the importance of keeping your child at home if they are unwell and monitor for symptoms. If students show any symptoms please get them PCR tested. There is a PRC testing site now across the road from the police station.

Restrictions ease from next week:

As a result of a number of restrictions being removed, next week we will return to:

- Assemblies: held outdoors with our first assembly being held in Week 6.
- Welcoming school volunteers into the canteen and to support with listening to children read.
- The Polly Farmer Homework club held outdoors on Wednesday afternoons
- Playgroup on Fridays, commencing Week 6 (11th March) outdoors
- Classes are able to participate in day excursions and incursions.

We are however still required to keep the number of visitors on school grounds to a minimum and appreciate the incredible school community support ensuring that drop offs and picks up remain from the gates. Reception - YR 2 teachers will continue to walk their students down to the gates at the end of the day.

All adult visitors must wear a face mask when onsite, practise physical distancing and not attend the site if they are unwell.

Once again I thank you all for your continued support.

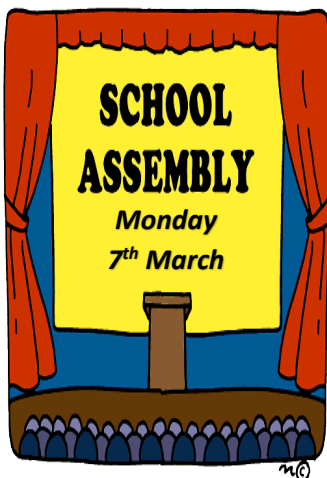

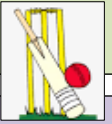

I enjoy being with my family, baking, gardening, listening to music and dancing in the mirror.

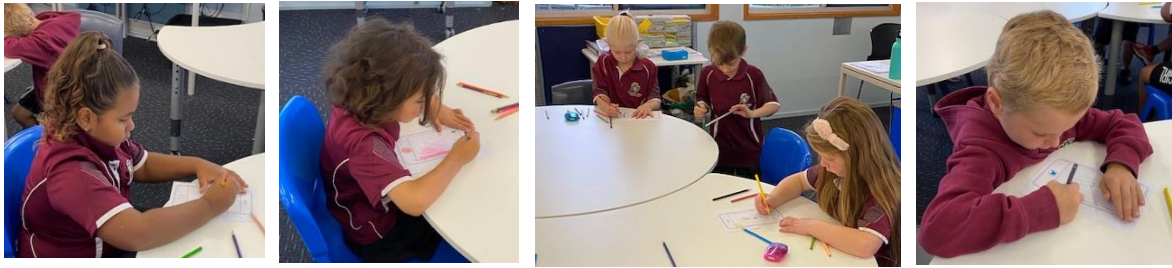


Aisha Nunn - ACEO

APPLYING FOR A SCHOOL CARD



You may be eligible for support to pay Material & Services fees and subject fees if you are a low income earner. School Card assistance **must be applied for each year** as the assessment process is based on your family income for the prior financial year. We recommend that you lodge your application for School Card assistance early each year. This will allow you to establish a payment plan with the school early in the year if your School Card application is not approved.
