From the Principal's Desk...
Dear Parents,
Welcome back! I hope you all managed to spend some quality time with your children and family during the break. We look forward to another busy term with an emphasis on student attendance. You would have all received a letter in the holidays outlining our process for following up unexplained student absence. Our aim is to reach a $90 \%$ attendance rate for all students.

End of semester reports were sent home with students at the end of last term. Student reports are not only an opportunity to see how your children are progressing but also a chance to check up on their attendance. Research has shown that students who miss as few as one day every two weeks can form a habit. This habit impacts on their learning as they are unable to learn what's being taught in class and often they fall behind. Research also tells us children who come to school in the early grades do well throughout the rest of their schooling.

How many days has your child missed this year? If it's a number of days it is never too late to get them back on track and break that habit. This will contribute to a successful school year and help make improvements to their learning.

## Preschool mid-year intake now open

The registration of interest process for mid-year intake into preschool in 2023 is now open as follows:

- Children born on or before 30 April will start preschool in term 1.
- Children born between 1 May and 31 October will start preschool in term 3 (mid-year).
This means families can register their interest now in enrolling in their local preschool to start in term 3 2023. Families can register their interest via the department's website by Friday 30 September 2022.
