How old do you have to be to use Snapchat?

Snapchat's terms of service state that users must be 13 years of age. Users have to enter their birth date to set up an account, but there is no age verification. This makes it easy for children under 13 to sign up. Common Sense Media rates Snapchat OK for teens 16 and up, mainly because there can be exposure to age-inappropriate content and marketing ploys, such as quizzes, that collect data.

Try this: This is a tough one, huh? We're going to figure this out together.




Instead of: Eat your food or you will go to bed hungry!





Time TO BAKE

Aim: To make ANZAC Biscuits



Ingredients:

- 1 cup of rolled oats
- 1 cup of plain flour
- 1 cup of sugar
- 125g of butter
- 2 tablespoons of golden syrup
- 2 tablespoons boiling water
- 1 teaspoon of bi-carb soda

Method:

1. Mix all dry ingredients in a large mixing bowl.
2. Melt the butter and the golden syrup together and stir to combine.
3. Make a well in the centre of the dry ingredients.
4. Add the melted butter and sugar into the well.
5. Dissolve the bi-carb soda in the hot water and add to the mixture.
6. Stir to combine all ingredients.
7. Roll teaspoons of the mixture into balls and place on a baking tray (2.5cm apart).
8. Press the mixture down with the back of a spoon.
9. Bake in the oven (180 degree celsius) for 12 minutes.
