We've been successful with our application for a 2022 Woolworths Junior Landcare Grant for our project, *Planting The Seed: Cultivating Future Sustainability Warriors*

The aim of our project is to establish and maintain a vegetable garden on site, to encourage parent and community engagement. The children will be involved in filling the garden beds, planting, cultivating and harvesting the seedlings, and using the resulting produce in our cooking program. The expected (environmental and educational) outcomes of the project include: an established vegetable garden and learning space, to allow for continued and future use by children, lifecycle and healthy eating education and parent engagement in the site.

Flinders View Preschool is one of 1,054 primary schools and early learning centres throughout Australia receiving a Woolworths Junior Landcare grant to help grow our next generation of environmental champions.

The children and teachers are looking forward to working and learning from this project and we'll keep you updated on the results.
